ALL IT TAKES IS TO BELIEVE

Salvation through Christ is a free gift and can only be received by faith in Jesus Christ alone (Ephesians 2:8-9). You need to admit your sins, repent, and believe with all your heart that Christ died on the cross to pay the full penalty of your sins, and that He rose again for your justification—1 Corinthians 15:1-4. The moment you truly believe this, your sins will be forgiven and you will be justified before God. This is what it means to be saved or born again!

Romans 3:24-26: "Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus: **25** Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God; **26** To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus."

You Have A Choice to Make <u>Now</u> Remember, there is no salvation apart from Jesus Christ. Would you reject Him? This may be your last chance! "...he that believeth not the Son shall not see life; but the wrath of God abideth on him." John 3:36. Or would you believe and trust Jesus Christ with your life? This is the right decision. "He that believeth on the Son hath everlasting life..." John 3:36. If you've trusted in Christ today, I congratulate you! You're now born again, you stand fully justified before God—John 3:36; 5:24; Rom. 5:8-9; Acts 13:38-39.

NOW THAT YOU ARE SAVED

With the assurance of salvation comes the assurance of eternity with God. That is what Jesus Christ accomplished (2 Corinthians 8:9). There are those who claim to be saved but are still not sure about their eternity. This is because they trust in their own works.

Good work has its place in the Christian life, but it cannot save or keep you saved. No one can do enough to qualify. Salvation can only be by the righteousness of Christ, and that was what you got when you believed.

So, the reason why you're going to heaven is because when you trusted in Christ, your sins were forgiven and His righteousness of was imputed to you. This is what qualifies you for heaven.

THE MOST IMPORTANT QUESTION

Where will you go after you die? Have you ever thought about it?



THE MOST IMPORTANT QUESTION

Life is full of questions...But you must be able to answer the most important of all: Where will you go after you die? Maybe you're thinking "when I die, that's the end." Wrong! Life continues after death. "And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment" Hebrews 9:27. Man is made in three parts: body, soul, and spirit. (See Genesis 2:7). When a person dies, only the body dies. The soul is who you really are, and will continue your existence after you die while your body is buried. Still not convinced? Read the following passage:

Revelation 20:11-15: "And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. 12 And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, according to their works. 13 And the sea gave up the dead which were in it; and death and hell delivered up the dead which were in them: and they were judged every man according to their works ... " Think about what you just read. The decision you make after reading this tract will determine whether you will be justified or condemned at that judgment.

THE TWO DESTINATIONS

I hope you're convinced about the afterlife by now. Have you thought about where you will go after you die? How do you intend to get there? There are only two options: **Heaven** or **Hell!** For you to go to heaven though, you must take the <u>Way</u> provided by God Himself through His Son Jesus Christ. Any other means than trusting in Christ alone will lead you into condemnation!

BEING GOOD WILL NOT HELP

It is true that doing good is good. No one wants to be a relative, friend, or neighbor to an evil person. Keeping the commandment is also a good thing to do. After all, the Bible commands it. But in themselves, these things will not grant you access to God or to Heaven. The salvation that God offers can only be received by faith alone. Doing good and keeping the commandments only work for those who are already saved.

The kind of righteousness demanded by God cannot be attained by keeping the Law. Listen to the Bible:

Galatians 3:21: "Is the law then against the promises of God? God forbid: for if there had been a law given which could have given life, verily righteousness should have been by the law."

Galatians 2:21: "I do not frustrate the grace of God: for if righteousness come by the law, then Christ is dead in vain."

THE RIGHT WAY TO HEAVEN

If none of the above would earn you righteousness, how then do you become righteous before God you ask? The Bible provides the answer:

Accept Who You Really Are—A sinner who is on his/her way to suffer in hell for all eternity. You said "but I'm not a sinner, I'm a good person!" Don't be deceived, all have sinned! Consider the following verses: Romans 3:12: "They are all gone out of the way, they are together become unprofitable; there is none that doeth good, no, not one." Romans 3:23: "For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God." 1 John 1:8: "If we say that we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us." No unforgiven sinner will go to heaven. This is why you need to repent of your sins.

Come to the Cross and Be Washed in the Blood—Ephesians 1:7: "In whom we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace". See also John 3:16; Romans 5:6-11; Romans 6:23. Jesus Christ fully paid the penalty of your sins with His own blood. God demands that blood be shed for the forgiveness of sin—Hebrews 9:22. But the sacrifice must be without blemish. That is Jesus Christ, and there is no other options apart from Him. This is why you must trust in what He did for you.
